<b>Additional Credits to reach 120</b> (may include general electives and general education courses as needed to meet degree requirements)
In order to graduate from Northern Vermont University with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration: Management Concentration, students must have a minimum of 120 credits <b>(33 credits hours at the 3000 or 4000 level must be from Northern Vermont University)</b> . Students who graduate with an Associate Degree in Business from the Community College of Vermont may enter the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration program. All college-level courses from CCV or other accredited institutions will be accepted by Northern Vermont University (non-credit courses and remedial/developmental courses will not be accepted) and applied where possible to the credits required to reach the 120 credits necessary to complete a bachelor's degree.
