Applying:

- Go to Northern Vermont University website and start the application process. www.northernvermont.edu/apply
- Along with your application, please also submit official copy of all previously attended colleges/universities
- If you earned less than 18 college credits, High School Transcript is required
- Application Fee of \$50
- We are rolling admissions. You can apply at any time and we will make a decision to your application as soon as it becomes complete.

After Applying:

- Please make sure to add Northern Vermont University (NVU) into your FAFSA. Our **school code is 003688**
- Please make sure to activate your VSCS (Vermont State Colleges System) Portal, so you can check your Financial Aid Award Letter
- You will receive your Transfer Credit Evaluation within a week after being accepted

Enrollment Process:

- Submit the \$200 enrollment deposit if you choose to enroll at NVU after being accepted
- NVU Admissions will provide you with the enrollment checklist, where you will be able to start the process of course registration, housing registration, etc.
