SELECTION PROCESS

Housing selection will take place on April 23rd at your assigned time. Rooms will be selected in order of credits earned, taking into account attained cumulative GPA as of fall 2020.

Each student's selection time can be found in their eRezLife profile starting April 16 at 12 p.m.

Students who have an earlier selection time than their desired roommate(s) or suitemate(s) may pull them in during their selection time.

During Housing Selection, Student Life will offer a drop-in help session over Zoom. Having any issues? Drop in the session and get personal help on the spot. This link will be included in emails to students:

SELECTION PROCESS STEPS

After you have applied for housing in eRezLife, you can check your application status when you log in. Your application and status can be viewed under the Housing Overview page. Prior to entering the Room Lottery Process, you will be able to preview rooms under the Housing Overview page.

You may search for specific rooms. Vacant rooms are indicated by a simple bed frame icon. Rooms that are unavailable are indicated by an icon of a bed frame with a red "x" over it. To make the room selection process easier, you can mark your favorite room(s) and view only your favorite room(s) during the Room Lottery Process later.

Once you are eligible to enter the Room Lottery Process, you will see a 'Browse Rooms' button at the top of the Housing Overview page.

Click the 'Browse Rooms' button to browse rooms and make your selection

You may search for specific rooms by building/section and/or residence preference set up.

Click the bed icon to select your room. You will not be

able to make a section on any unavailable rooms.

A dialog window will be prompted with details of the selected room. Click the 'choose this bed' button.

Review the details of your room reservation. Click on 'Assign me now' to confirm your assignment. Click the 'look at other rooms' link to browse other rooms.

Alternately, you can also cancel the current room reservation and look at other available rooms. Select a meal plan of your choice during this section as well.

If you have a roommate group, you can also pull them in and place your roommates nearby. You must confirm this before the assignment is finalized.

HOUSING DEPOSIT

In order to select a room during housing selection, you must first pay a non-refundable \$100 deposit to Student Services Office on the third floor of Vail.

Deposits are due by 4 p.m. on April 16.

SINGLE ROOMS

All rooms on campus are currently single-occupancy rooms at the double room rate for Fall 2021. If COVID regulations change to allow for roommates, students will have the opportunity to opt-in if they so choose. The room rate will not change if you opt in to a double room.

SELECTION ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to choose a room during the housing selection process students must have the following:

- ✓ Paid \$100 housing deposit by April 16;
- ✓ Be registered for 9+ credits for the fall 2021 semester;
- ✓ Be financially and medically cleared (no financial holds and all medical records submitted); and
- ✓ Completed housing contract.

It is important that you read the contract thoroughly as you are responsible for its contents. Once your contract is signed, you are required to fulfill those conditions. This includes living on campus for the full academic year (unless you are dismissed or withdraw from the college).
