

NORTHERN VERMONT UNIVERSITY FINAL EXAM SCHEDULE – SPRING 2019

Final examination week begins Monday, May 13, and ends Thursday, May 16. Each examination period will be two hours long. There is one possible common examination time during the week. This is on Tuesday, May 14, 10:30am-12:30pm.

For classes which normally meet at the standard times: Table A indicates the assigned days and times for the final examination.

For classes which normally meet at non-standard times: Table B indicates how to determine on what days and times the final examination will be held.

For courses which are listed in this course bulletin as having meeting times “arranged,” no examination period has been assigned. The instructor and the students will have to consult to arrange a mutually workable examination time.

TABLE B EXAMINATION TIMES FOR CLASSES WITH NON-STANDARD CLASS-TIMES

1. A class which meets a non-standard length of time each session, but which starts at a standard time, will hold its examination at the same time as standard classes which have that starting time.

2. A class which meets a non-standard sequence of days will hold its examination at the same time as a standard class which has the same first meeting day of the week as a non-standard sequence.

Example: A class which meets at 8:00 on MTuW is a non-standard sequence of days. Its first meeting day is Monday, and its examination period will be the same time as the 8:00-8:50 MWF classes.

3. A class which starts at a non-standard time generally starts in the middle of a standard meeting time. It will hold its examination at the same time as the standard class.

Example: A class which meets at 12:15-2:00 P.M. on TuTh starts during the standard class time of 11:30-12:45 on TuTh. Its examination period will be the same time as the 11:30-12:45 TuTh classes.

CLASSROOMS IN WHICH EXAMINATIONS WILL BE HELD

Scheduled examinations will be held in the same classroom in which the class normally meets. Instructors who need an alternate classroom in which to hold examinations should contact the Registrar's Office. Special arrangements will have to be made for common finals at the time the request is approved.
